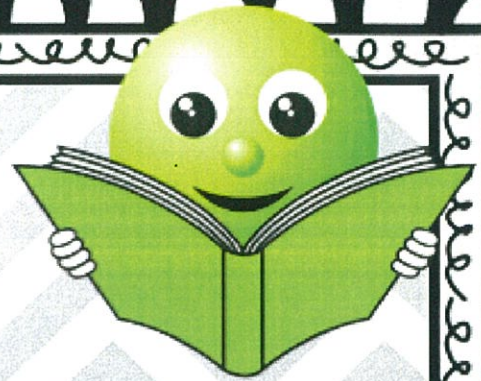

Dear Parents,
Here is some information to keep you informed.

Mathematics:

For February we will continue with number-work (workbook, worksheets from Canadian Grade 1 programme), estimating, fractions, measuring.

Science:

We will continue with fruit and vegetables for 2 more weeks: Then- The Solar System until mid-March.

- Parts of a plant
- Parts of a flower
- Pollination
- Planting
- Fruit (various activities-language, art, maths, baking etc.)
- Vegetables-identify vegetables and fruit
- Identify which part of a plant we eat- carrot (root), lettuce (leaf), celery (stem), apple tree (fruit)-we use the laptop/projector most days
